Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the promotion of respondent No.3, namely Tara Chand, to the post of Assistant Registrar, effected by the respondent-Department, vide order dated 25.12.2021 (Annexure P-11), has been done on the basis of fake documents submitted by him with the authorities concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case respondent No.3 is declared ineligible for the said promotion, the petitioner becomes eligible for the grant of said promotion to the post of Assistant Registrar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the same grievance has also been raised by the petitioner before respondent No.2 by filing representation dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-12), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to

respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 28.01.2021, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in the representation dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-12), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-12), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

It is made clear that all the personnel, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the said order, be given an opportunity of hearing in accordance with law before passing of the said order by respondent No.2.
