Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the husband of petitioner No.1 was working as Assistant Lineman with the respondent-Corporation and unfortunately, he died while performing his duties. Learned counsel submits that keeping in view the said incident, petitioner No.1 is entitled for the compensation on account of death of her husband while performing his duties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioner No.1 has already raised the said grievance before respondent No.2 by way of filing a representation dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-4), which is pending consideration with respondent No.2 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner No.1 for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after passing the speaking order, petitioner No.1 is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to her within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.
