The petitioner has filed the instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 for providing security of life and liberty of the petitioner as well as her family members from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 with a further prayer to take strict legal action against respondent No. 4/Arjun Kumar Yadav son of Abhay Yadav, who has committed repeated rape with the petitioner by alluring a false pretext to marry her and exploited career of the petitioner in active connivance of respondents No. 5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, an FIR qua the incident in question has already been registered by the police and as such, the instant petition has become infructuous.
