Present petition has been moved under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and to register appropriate criminal case against private respondents No.4 to 10 for allegedly giving beats to him on 28.04.2022. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that representation/complaint (Annexure P-4) in this regard has also been moved before the concerned authorities, but no action has been taken as of now.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Jaspreet Kaur, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that he will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to take action on the aforesaid representation.

State counsel submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioner in accordance with law.

In the light of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 28.04.2022 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
