Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.36 dated 25.02.2022, registered under Sections 458, 323, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 324 IPC (added later on), at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury on the left side of the head of the complainant, was simple in nature, as would decipher from medical report dated 20.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) and that the medical evidence does not support the case of the prosecution. He further submits that co-accused, namely, Harmandeep Singh, Harjeet Singh, Jagtar Singh and Beant Singh, have already been granted the concession of bail. Still further, it is submitted that there is a delay of 50 hours in lodging the FIR,

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The allegations against the petitioner are specific and serious in nature. The petitioner along with the co-accused scaled the wall of the house of the complainant; had opened the door from inside and

chased the complainant. The petitioner gave a gandas blow on the head of the complainant, which is a vital part. Moreover, there were total 11 injuries on the person of the complainant. The weapon used in the commission of the crime, is yet to be recovered. Thus, to unearth the truth and to know the names of the co-accused, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is a must.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
