The petitioner has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.59 dated 17.09.2021 registered under Sections 419/420/465/466/467/468/471 & 120-B IPC and Section 82 of Registration Act, 1908, at Police Station Block Majri, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

On 09.08.2022 the following order was passed:-

“Reply filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. Copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

List on 23rd November, 2022.

Arrest of the petitioner was stayed on 31st May, 2022.

The order is modified to extend that arrest of petitioner is stayed, subject to joining investigation.”

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harinder Singh, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 09.08.2022, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact, the interim order dated 09.08.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed off.

Needless to say that anything observed herein shall not be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
