Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing complaint case bearing COMA No.404 dated 23.07.2021, under Sections 22(3), 27(c) and 28-A of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jhajjar.

Vide order dated 29.07.2022, *ad interim* bail was granted to the petitioner with a direction to appear before the learned trial Court and on doing so, he was to be admitted to *interim* bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 29.07.2022, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 04.08.2022 and has already been admitted to the interim bail, after accepting the bail and surety bonds furnished by him.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.07.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
