Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, after retirement of the petitioner, the benefits with regard to the leave encashment and LTC, for which the petitioner is entitled for, have been withheld by the respondents on the ground that a sum of Rs.53,000/- is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide representation dated 23.02.2022 (Annexure P-4), the petitioner had already authorized the respondents to recover the pending amount of Rs.53,000/- from his retiral benefits, but respondent No.3 has not considered the said request, while replying to the legal notice dated 03.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) and declining the claim of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has no objection in case his retiral benefits are released by the respondents, after recovering the pending amount of Rs.53,000/- from the said benefits.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional A.G., Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that prayer of the petitioner for recovering the pending amount of Rs.53,000/- from his retiral benefits will be considered by the authorities concerned and after the said recovery, the remaining amount of the retiral benefits will be granted to the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions of learned State counsel, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage.

Ordered accordingly.
