It is submitted that land in dispute has been transferred to the petitioner by his father through a valid transfer deed. Yet, mutation has not been entered in favour of the petitioner. Legal notice dated 04.05.2022 has also not had any effect.

A perusal of the record shows that the petitioner has approached this Court without making any complaint before the Collector regarding the Naib Tehsildar. Thus, the writ petition is not entitled to be entertained.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this writ petition.
