This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to provide one more opportunity for Physical/Driving Test to the petitioner for the recruitment of the post of Fireman and consider the case of the petitioner for the post of Fireman as per advertisement No.1857 dated 26.03.2021 published in various news papers and applied on 12.07.2021 under General category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner could not appear on the previous date which was fixed for appearance of the petitioner for physical/driving test because of his medical condition. However, now he can appear for the said test and participate in the process of selection. The process of physical/driving test is still on, therefore, the petitioner deserves an opportunity to participate in the same.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anil Mehta, Senior Standing Counsel, along with Mr. Nishant Indal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents is also not averse to grant of one more opportunity to the petitioner but submits that it should not be taken as a precedent for any other candidate.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to grant one more opportunity to the petitioner to appear in the aforesaid test which is stated to be scheduled on 28.05.2022.
