The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.102 dated 13.05.2022 registered under Section 11 of the Haryana Control of Bricks Supply Order 1972, Section 37 AIR (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, Sections 21(1) and 21(4)(A) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and Sections 379 and 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rampura, District Rewari.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Teja Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 30.05.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.05.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
