1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.10.2021, in CWP-21909-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 29.10.2021, reveals that CWP-21909-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the claim made in representations dated 24.02.2020, 24.02.2020, 21.08.2020, 28.09.2020 and 01.04.2021, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and to furnish a copy of the decision to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P/1, claim of the petitioner has been rejected by the respondent vide order Annexure R/2 dated 28.06.2022 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant

petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order Annexure R/2 dated 28.06.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
