1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 13.03.2019 in CRM-M-48185-2018.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that CRM-M-48185-2018 in respect of which the instant petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 13.03.2019 therein, has been compromised between the parties, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
