1. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
2. Permission granted.
3. Consequently, the extant petition is dismissed as withdrawn, but it is open to the petitioners to, on anvil of Annexure R-3, make an address for the inclusion in the complaint, of the persons mentioned in Annexure R-3, and, to also seek a relief from the learned trial Judge concerned, for discharge, or, exclusion from the complaint, of the persons, other than those mentioned in Annexure R-3.
4. Moreover, liberty is yet left open to take all appropriate recourses before the learned trial Judge concerned, for challenging the report of the Government Analyst concerned, if yet permissible, in accordance with law.
