The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as "CrPC") by the petitioner for seeking concession of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 04 dated 08.01.2021 under Sections 302 and 459 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereinafter referred to as 'IPC') (Section 201 IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Urban State-Hisar, District Hisar.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the trial is at advance stage and that out of 19 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 12 witnesses have already been examined. The case is now fixed for 18.08.2022 for recording evidence of the prosecution witness. The prosecution shall make every endeavour to ensure expeditious examination of the prosecution witnesses and that the remaining prosecution evidence shall be concluded within a period of three months from the next date fixed

before the trial Court for recording prosecution evidence i.e 18.08.2022.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage.
