Present petition has been filed with a prayer that respondents No. 2 to 4 be directed to proceed against the accused keeping in view the representation filed by the petitioner dated 03.06.2021 (Annexure P-4) and also for conducting fair investigation in FIR No.129 dated 29.05.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 148 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

After notice of motion, a reply has been filed wherein, it has been stated that after the registration of FIR No.129 dated 29.05.2021, keeping in view the representation filed by the petitioner, a DDR No.38 dated 29.05.2021 has also been registered against the accused therein and as, not only the petitioner but the other accused were also facing bailable

offences, they have been enlarged on bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that he has instructions to submit that after due investigation, the appropriate report as envisaged under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C will be submitted before the competent Court of law within a period of next two months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed.
