Third petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.18 dated 12.03.2019, under Sections 22, 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Jourkian, District Mansa.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submit that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, their client would be satisfied in case the trial is concluded expeditiously.

Learned State Counsel, who is present through Video-Conference, raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

If that be so, keeping in view the custody of the petitioner and the fact that out of 10 prosecution witnesses, 06 have already been examined, learned trial Court is requested to conclude the matter before 31.05.2022 if there is no legal impediment.

It is also made clear that unnecessary adjournments on asking of either of the parties be avoided by learned Presiding Officer.
