By this petition, the petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.72, dated 22.05.2019, having been registered at Police Station Division no.2, District Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (with Sections 27, 29 and 85 of the NDPS Act having been added later on), Section 52-A of the Prison Act, 1894 and Section 411 of the IPC.

The matter had been adjourned on two occasions earlier with learned State counsel having submitted that in fact, as per his instructions, unfortunately, the petitioner has died but he sought time to take firm instructions in that regard, with learned counsel for the petitioner also having sought time for the same.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought an adjournment through the coordinator of the video conference, with learned State counsel

however submitting that he has taken firm instructions that unfortunately the event has happened.

That being so, this petition no longer survives and is consequently disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
