MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.212 dated 27.07.2018 under Section 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 23.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“.....Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the matter was compromised between the parties before the Economic Offences Wing, however, earlier the petitioner could not honour the compromise. Now he intends to settle the dispute with the complainant in toto. To show his bona fide, the petitioner is ready to pay an initial amount of Rs.50,000/- to the complainant. Notice of motion for 18.02.2019. Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Baldev Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.10.2018 is made absolute.
