Present petition was filed in the year 2012 with the following prayer:-

It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and impugned criminal complaint No.65 of 02.06.2012 tilted as “*Ritu Sharma Versus Vikram Arora and others*” pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar (Annexure P-6) under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners may kindly be set aside and quashed in the interest of justice.”
