SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The only grievance reared in the instant petition, is that the investigating officer failing to make the arrest of respondent No. 3-Ranjit Singh son of Jagat Singh. However, the learned State Counsel, who is assisted by ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submits that, since the above had fled to Canada, therefore, his arrest could not be made.

2. The learned State Counsel further submits, that the Secretary (Home), State of Punjab, has accessed the Ministry of External Affairs, for the drawing of extradition proceedings, by the Embassy of India, with Canada, for ensuring the extradition of the above, from Canada to India.

3. Consequently, it cannot be said that, there is any indolence, on the part of the investigating officer, to not promptly cause the arrest of Ranjit Singh son of Jagat Singh.
