Prayer in this petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 is for extending the parole granted to the petitioner for a period of one month on account of the fact that the petitioner requires time for the medical treatment and operation of the nose of his daughter as it needs urgent surgery.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted parole on 05.05.2022 till 05.06.2022 for the purpose of repair of his house and he is to surrender on 05.06.2022, however, on account injury sustained by his daughter, his parole may be extended so that he could take care of his daughter for her medical treatment.

Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Heard.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the

facts and circumstances, I deem it appropriate to extend the parole of the petitioner for another period of one month.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The parole of the petitioner is extended by one month.

The petitioner will surrender before the jail authorities on 05.07.2022 by 05:00 P.M.
