The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.192 dated 07.11.2021 registered under Section 304-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Moga, District Moga to which Sections 304, 379 and 511 of the IPC were added lateron.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sikandar Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 31.05.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 31.05.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
