Prayer in the petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents for playing fraud by way of fraudulently receiving Rs. 11,50,000/- from the petitioner in lieu of selling the land by way of agreement to sell dated 15.11.2010.

Short affidavit dated 20.07.2022 of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, submitted by the learned State counsel is taken on record.

Learned State counsel points out that as per the aforesaid short affidavit, the inquiry was marked to the Superintendent of Police (Headquarters), Moga, and in view of the inquiry report and legal opinion of

the District Attorney (Legal), an FIR No. 159 dated 17.07.2022 under Sections 418, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dharamkot was registered against Swaran Singh, petitioner and Baldev Singh.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above, he does not want to press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
