On 03.08.2022, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the respondents has furnished a copy of communication dated 26.07.2022 wherein it is stated that the respondent-bank has decided not to contest the matter. It is further stated that the respondent-bank is ready to consider petitioner’s case on sympathetic grounds on receipt of a duly filled in application and on fulfillment of all eligibility criteria prescribed in the scheme. However, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

A copy of communication dated 26.07.2022 be supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, during the course of the day.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 20.09.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner be notified of the date fixed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that the offer made by the respondent-Bank is acceptable to the petitioner and prays that the same be ordered to be disposed of in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents has graciously accepted the said request made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the consensus, noticed above, learned counsel for the parties jointly pray that the present petition be disposed of with the directions that the petitioner would file a duly filled in application afresh and on fulfillment of all eligibility criteria prescribed in the scheme, the same would be sympathetically considered by the respondent-Bank.

This petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
