ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Aggrieved by the unfair investigation by the respondents, the complainant has come up before this Court by filing the present petition under Section 482 CrPC.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the charges were framed way back in the year 2019 and the trial is going on.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of this Court to the order dated 07.11.2019, passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. The said order reads as under:-

“On 30.09.2019, the Investigating Officer was directed to move an application before the trial Court for recording of the statement of petitioner Hem Lata as a prosecution witness.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the statement of the petitioner has not been recorded so far.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sundar Singh, submits that the next before the trial Court is 14.11.2019.

List again on 12.12.2019.

The Superintendent of Police, Mewat is directed to ensure that the statement of the petitioner is recorded on the date so fixed and necessary protection be also given to her for appearance before the trial Court.”

Given the statement of counsel for the State, present petition has become infructuous.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous, subject to complying with the order dated 07.11.2019. Petitioner is at liberty to approach this Court again in case, compliance of the order dated 07.11.2019 has not been made. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
