The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.89 dated 18.02.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324 (Sections 326, 365, 452, 506 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh (Annexure P-1).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.05.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Mahender Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

The learned counsel for the complainant on the other hand contends that the averments contained in para 18 of this petition is

factually incorrect as there are two other FIRs pending against the petitioner.

Be that as it may, the fact of the matter is that the petitioner has been attributed an injury attracting Section 323 IPC and it a case of version and cross-version.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 30.05.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
