Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 84 dated 02.04.2022 registered under Sections 381, 411, 34 IPC, at Police Station Division No. 6, District Ludhiana.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Vide order dated 31.05.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Balbir Singh, submits that that despite availing two opportunities, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.
