Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking direction to the official respondents to investigate and conclude the enquiry in complaint bearing PC 990 dated 16.04.2021, Annexure P-8.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that despite the complaint having been submitted more than one year back, the same is not being enquired into. He submits that the petitioners are being repeatedly called to the Police Station and are being pressurized to compromise the matter with the private respondents. Counsel submits that the petitioners have submitted representations dated 07.08.2021, Annexures P-9 and P-10, respectively, which are pending and the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the same.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 6 only, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 6.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the complaint and representations, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala-respondent No.2, to examine the representation dated 07.08.2021, Annexure P-10, and take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
