This is a petition seeking quashing of order dated 11.4.2022 passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person in FIR No.151 dated 6.9.2021, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station City Moga.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within two weeks from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

In case the petitioner surrenders within two weeks from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within one day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
