This is the petitioner's second attempt to get bail, pending trial in a criminal case, arising from FIR No.134, dated 02.07.2020, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Shimla Puri, District Ludhiana.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith another accused was found in conscious possession of 14000 Tramadol Hydrochloride intoxicating tablets, which is a prohibited substance under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner, although, made sincere attempts, however, failed to make out a fresh case for grant of bail. Hence, dismissed. However, since the FIR was registered on 02.07.2020, the trial court is requested to make sincere endeavour for the expeditious disposal of the case.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
