[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 20.04.2022 in CWP No.7894 of 2022 in case titled as M/s Jassi Govt. Contractor vs. The State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.7894 of 2022 was disposed of by directing respondent No.5 (i.e. respondent No.4 herein) to decide representation dated 23.12.2021 filed by the petitioner and to pass appropriate orders in respect thereto in accordance with law preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy the order, with further direction that any delay in disbursing the payment would result in imposition of interest @ 6% per annum for the delayed payment from the date of accrual till final realization.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to issuance of notice to respondent No.4 on 31.05.2022, the

has been decided by respondent No.4 and payment as per entitlement made to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn.

[4] In the light of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.4 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
