[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings
against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order,
Annexure P-1, dated 16.11.2020, in CWP No.19351 of 2020 in case titled as
'Satish KumarversusState of Haryana and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP
No.19351 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to
consider and decide the petitioner's claim as raised in the legal notice as
early as possible, preferably within three months from the date of receipt
of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the
respondent rejected the claim of the petitioner, as raised in the legal
notice, vide order dated 19.08.2021 and that in the circumstances, the
petitioner does not press the instant petition as order dated 19.08.2021
rejecting the claim of the petitioner has already been challenged by the

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
