The *sanad* was prepared in the year 2015. The petitioner was proceeded against ex parte in the partition proceedings and thus, an application for setting aside the ex parte order was filed. The application was, however, dismissed. Further, appeal and revision have also failed.

The revisional order is dated 17.07.2018 and that is the order impugned in the writ petition.

The writ petition having been filed after more than four years of the passing of the impugned order, the same is liable to be dismissed on the ground of delay and laches as there is no explanation for not challenging the order earlier.
