The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No.59 dated
18.06.2021, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station
Sadar Kurali District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners,
who are father-in-law and mother-in-law of the complainant have been
falsely implicated in the case in hand on account of a marital discord

between their son and the complainant. He further submits that totally false and fabricated allegations have been levelled against them of subjecting their daughter-in-law to physical and mental harassment for not getting dowry as per their expectations and also of misappropriating her dowry articles. Learned counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 12.8.2021 the petitioners have joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, assisted by ASI Kamaljeet Singh does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further on instructions submits that the petitioners have cooperated during investigation and their further investigation is not required by the investigating agency.

Learned counsel for the complainant has, however, opposed the prayer made by the counsel opposite by urging that in the wake of serious and specific allegations of cruelty levelled against the petitioners, they may not be extended the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.8.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
