Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the pleas, as have been raised herein, before the trial Court at appropriate stage.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

However, in case, the petitioner, who is a lady, aged about 54 years moves an application before the trial Court seeking exemption from personal appearance, the trial Court shall consider the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
