SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, seeking quashing of FIR No.63 dated 06.05.2022 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR (Annexure P-1) has arisen out of a matrimonial dispute and petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant has joined the investigation in deference to the order dated 20.10.2022 passed by this Court. Still further, he submits that dispute has been settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and

a petition seeking divorce by mutual consent has been instituted.

Upon instructions from HC Malkit Singh, State counsel has affirmed this fact and submits that petitioner has cooperated with the investigation process and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the fact that matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled, but without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Order dated 20.10.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
