[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 03.08.2018, in CWP No.19156 of 2018 in case titled as '**Mohinder Singh versus Shiromani Gurudwara Prabhandak Committee (SGPC), Shri Amritsar Sahib and another**'.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that order dated 30.03.2022 has been passed in compliance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 03.08.2018 in CWP No.19156 of 2018, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.
