In CRM-M-22528-2020, the petitioner has sought cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 11.01.2018 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar.

In CRM-M-6200-2018, the petitioner has inter alia sought issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to involve a female officer in SIT constituted for the investigation of the FIR bearing No. 144 dated 29.12.2017, Under Sections 354/354-A/506/509 IPC read with 67/67-A of the IT Act 2005.
