[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-4, dated 01.06.2020, in CWP No.7556 of 2020.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-4), reveals that while issuing notice of motion to respondent Nos.1, 2 and 5 for 27.08.2020, it was ordered that there would be no further constructions and installation of idols in the structure being constructed at the site i.e. Plot Nos.5080, 5081 and 5082 with new numbers as MCB Z-10327, 10328 and 10329 situated in Afim Wali Gali, Bathinda, till further orders.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of disposal of CWP No.7556 of 2020, the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
