AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The writ petition in the nature of Habeas Corpus was filed (by impleading the alleged detainees as petitioners) for releasing the petitioners from the unlawful custody of the mob gathered at outside H. No. 179, Guru Arjan Dev Colony, Rajpura, Punjab.

It is not being disputed that as on date none of the petitioners is under illegal detention.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is not disputing the fact that detainees (petitioners) are no longer in any illegal detention. However, he submits that grievances still survives.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for. Petition is disposed of. However, petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievances, if any.
