1. At the outset, learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to the learned trial Court to decide the application under Order 9 Rule 13 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, Annexure P/10 dated 21.09.2021, in a time bound manner.
