[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that order (Annexure CP-1) dated 17.12.2018 in CWP No.20984 of 2016, violation of which is complained of in the instant petition having been stayed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the instant petition in the eventuality of vacation of order of stay passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court or dismissal of the SLP.

[2] The same is not objected to by learned counsel for the respondent.

[3] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
