SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The petitioners have approached this Court as they have not been permitted to appear for final semester examination on account of shortage of lecturers.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the list of students with short lecturers was posted only a day before the commencement of examination and they were hardly given any time to seek condonation of the shortage of lecturers. Most of the petitioners have medical reasons and in cases of the others, the shortage is minimal and is entitled to be condoned. Representation dated 25.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) has been submitted, but the same has had no effect on the respondents.

A perusal of the representation shows that as per the petitioners themselves a list was posted nine days before the commencement of the examination. Thus, an incorrect and false argument has been raised. The petitioners had sufficient time to get the shortage condoned but they have not done so. They cannot expect any relief at the hands of the Courts of Equity.

Examination has already commenced w.e.f. 25.05.2022. Under the circumstances, no interference is called for.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
