ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the investigation is complete and cancellation report is in the process of being filed.

Learned counsel for the State further submits that once the cancellation report is being filed, the right remedy is to file the protest petition before the concerned Magistrate. It is for the petitioner to file a protest petition or not.

Since given the statement of learned counsel for the State, the petition in the present form is not maintainable and the same is disposed of. However, it shall be open for the petitioner to either file a protest petition or file a petition for re-investigation by any other agency including investigation by any other specialized agency of the State of Haryana. Filing of the present petition and its withdrawal shall not come in the way in case the petitioner approaches this Court by filing a fresh petition.

The petition is disposed of with liberty aforesaid.

All pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed.
