The only dispute in the present revision petition is as to whether the plaint was liable to be returned in view of Section 15 of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015 or the matter was required to be transferred.

A reading of the impugned order shows that the attention of the Court was not drawn to the aforesaid fact.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that an application under Section 15 of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015 was filed with a prayer to transfer the case to the Commercial Court.

Since, this matter has not been considered by the Court, therefore, it would not be appropriate to entertain this revision petition, at this stage.

Let the petitioner, at the first instance, file an appropriate application before the Court in this regard.

With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
