Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.142 dated 3.6.2021 registered under Sections 323, 354, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station City Narwana, District Jind.

By virtue of the order dated 14.7.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner.
