AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

These petitions were filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 349 dated 11.12.2020, under Sections 406, 420 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Safidon, District Jind.

The petitioners were granted interim bail by this court subject to joining investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Ranbir Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation though their specimen signatures are required.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that specimen signatures have already been taken by the investigating agency, however,

the petitioners are still ready to give specimen signatures, if required.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the confirmation of interim anticipatory bail.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, considering that custody of the petitioners is not required, the orders granting interim anticipatory bail are made absolute.
