Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.368 dated 12.11.2016, registered under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, has pointed out that in the present case, the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender on 12.07.2019.

Today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

The petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and is thus, evading the process of law and there is no explanation forthcoming as none appeared on behalf of the petitioner and thus, the present petition deserves to be dismissed and is accordingly, dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, if so advised, after incorporating all the subsequent facts including the factum with respect to the petitioner having been declared proclaimed offender and after annexing all the relevant zimini orders.
