Mr. Gagan Bajaj, Advocate has put in appearance and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2 in the Court, which is taken on record.

On 06.06.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of FIR No.74 dated 23.04.2019 registered under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondent No.1. State counsel submits that allegation in the FIR (Annexure P-1) is that the petitioner was rashly driving the ambulance which hit a barricade causing injuries to three police officials, who were on duty. He submits that neither the

complainant nor two of the injured police officials, are party to the compromise (Annexure P-2). He seeks and is granted time to file response.

Respondent No.2 be served for 02.08.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
